I am writing regarding your request for information, which I received on the 18 June 2007. In that request, you asked us for the following information:

"The so-called 'Scud files' as referred to by the UNMOVIC Draft Work Programme dated 17 March 2003, ref: www.un.org/Depts/unmovic/documents/draftW.pdf, as was contained in the 12 000 pages of the full, and final and complete (FFCD) declaration submitted by Iraq on December 7, 2002, which was at that time supplied to the British Government

N.B I would obviously prefer an English language version of this document, being as the original may well have been supplied in Arabic. A paper or CD-ROM version would be equally acceptable.

If the Cabinet Office does not hold this information, please inform me accordingly, indicating which department or branch of Government currently holds this information, and please also advise me of FOI contact details for that department or branch"
